

- 7) A nomination committee, charged with putting forth the next years skte of officers at the annual meeting, shall be chaired by the officer-at-large and have one Oklahoma director to the IBBA as a committee member. The secretary shall provide the nominations, via mail, to the general membership no less than thirty days before the annual meeting, The president shall also accept nominations from the floor at the annual meeting. The majority vote of the membership present at the annual meeting shall elect the officers for the next year. The officer's term shall run from January 1 st through December 31 st.
- 8) In the event an officer fails to fulfill their position's responsibilities or adequately serve the membership's needs, the membership may remove the individual from office by a majority vote of the membership present at any meeting called by the president or secretary with a minimum of twenty days advance mail notice.
- 9) The By-Laws may be amended at any regular meeting of the membership, or at any special meeting called for that purpose, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members there present in person: provided, however, that any proposed amendment shall be reduced to writing and be filed with the Secretary or President of the Association, at least thirty days prior to such meeting. Any such proposed amendment shall clearly and concisely set out all amendments sought, and a copy thereof shall be sent to each active member of the Association, then in good standing, not less than twenty days prior to the regular or special meeting at which same is to be voted upon.

C) Meetings:

Annual Meeting: Shall be held at 1 p.m., on the first Saturday of December, conducted by the president, at the Junction of 1-40 & Hwy 99 at the Canadian Valley Co-op beginning in the year 2000. (Revised 3-10-00)

Annual Meeting: Revision 11-3-2001— To be held in December on a date, at a time, and a place determined appropriate by the OBA officers and conducted by the president.

Sales Meeting(s): Shall be scheduled in the town of the scheduled sale(s), conducted by the sales vice-president, with the president present, and shall address items of interest to consignors and potential consignors. The date of the sales meeting shall be as deemed appropriate by the sales vice-president. A minimum of twenty days mail notice of the meeting shall be provided to the full membership.

Mid-Year Meeting: The Mid-Year Meeting will be an OBA Field Day &/or Picnic meeting with the location, date and time to be arranged by the Promotions Vice President and presented to the membership at the Annual meeting or no later than the March Safes meeting. The president and all vice-presidents shall provide a summary of activities completed, their outcome, and of up-coming events. (Revised 3-10-00)
